Dear Candidate/Treasurer:

The purpose of this letter is to remind all candidates and committees participating in the 2007 General Election to file a report of financial activity. This reminder is being sent to all candidates, even though some candidates have already filed either the Form A-1 or A-2 for the General Election.

Please review the Compliance Manual, which was forwarded to you recently, to review your filing obligation. Note that the Primary Election and the General Election are considered to be two separate elections requiring separate reports. **Even candidates spending no money for an election, as well as withdrawn candidates, are required to file reports.** Contact the Compliance staff of the Commission at (609) 292-8700 or toll free within New Jersey at 1-888-313-ELEC (3532) if you have any questions or if you did not receive a Compliance Manual. Also, we invite you to visit our website at www.elec.state.nj.us. The Compliance Manual, reporting dates, forms, electronic filing information, and other useful information and materials can be accessed on the website.

The filing dates for the 2007 General Election are as follows: October 9, 2007 (29-day pre-election); October 26, 2007 (11-day pre-election); and, November 26, 2007 (20-day post-election). If a final report is filed at the 20-day postelection report, no additional reports are required; otherwise, reporting must continue. Consult the Manual for additional details regarding reporting after the 20-day postelection report.
